Main Arena

Class 1) Junior & Senior Summer Show Jumping 70cm Qualifier

Teams to comprise of 4 Junior or 4 Senior members.
Fences 70cms in first round. (Individual competitors also welcome)

Class 2) Junior & Senior Summer Show Jumping 80cm Qualifier

Teams to comprise of 4 Junior or 4 Senior members.
Fences 80cms in first round. (Individual competitors also welcome)

Class 3) Junior & Senior Summer Show Jumping 90cm Qualifier

Teams to comprise of 4 Junior or 4 Senior members.
Fences 90cms in first round. (Individual competitors also welcome)

Class 4) Summer Show Jumping 100cm Qualifier

Teams to comprise of 4 Junior/Senior members in any combination,
Fences 100cm in first round. (Individual competitors also welcome)

Class 5) Summer Show Jumping 110cm Qualifier

Teams to comprise of 4 Junior/Senior members in any combination,
Fences 110cm in first round. (Individual competitors also welcome)

Rules

1. Declaration forms must be handed in to organiser 30 minutes before the team class starts.
2. No changes to teams will be accepted once declaration forms have been handed in.
3. No major changes will be accepted after 3pm on Thursday 20th July 2017. Only straight substitutions will be accepted after this time, i.e. name of horse and/or rider taken out and replaced by another. No movements from one team to another will be allowed after this time.
4. *All classes run under British Riding Club rules/BS Rules.*
5. Flu certificates will be checked in accordance with BRC rules. Failure to produce a valid vet certificate will incur elimination. (Competitors maybe allowed to compete HC at the discretion of the organiser.)
6. The organisers and land owners will not hold themselves responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever, however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
7. Competitors must wear correct dress and hard hats complying with the BRC rules at all times when riding. *Tack will be checked in accordance with BRC rules and riders will not compete if not complying.* All hats to be checked and tagged.
8. The decisions of the judges and/or organisers are final.
9. Any objection must be made to the show secretary in writing within 30 minutes of closing the class, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which may be refunded.
10. The judge reserves the right to disqualify competitors for unsportsmanlike conduct or abuse of the horse/pony.
11. Riding Clubs are respectfully reminded that a preliminary entry means a commitment to pay the area fee.
