Teams are required to provide 2 helpers per team or 1 helper per 2 individuals entered. **Names and contact details of helpers should be provided at the time of entry. Failure to provide helpers could result in elimination of teams.**

Eligibility for all classes can be found in the current BRC Handbook. Eligibility will be taken from the close of pre-entries. All competitors must be registered members on the BRC membership platform (Sport:80) by the last working day before the competition date. Anyone failing to meet the eligibility criteria will be disqualified and informed by BRC HQ when the results are processed.

Rules and Regulations

This competition will run under BRC Rules, anyone in attendance will be bound by the BRC Code of Conduct. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link: <https://www.bhs.org.uk/british-riding-clubs/brc-handbook/>

All entrants must submit a pre-entry to BRC (fees can be found in the current BRC Handbook) at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier. Pre-entries must be made via the pre-entry website:

Late pre-entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £5 per individual and £10 per team (payable to BRC HQ) if space permits. **Late entries cannot be guaranteed and therefore must not be paid for until approval from the organiser has been gained.**

By making a pre-entry the team manager / club entry organiser enters into a binding obligation to pay the area entry fee, regardless of whether the club team/individual competes or not. Failure to do so will result in disciplinary action against the club at the discretion of BRC.

NO MAJOR CHANGES AFTER 3pm on 13 May 2024. Only direct substitute of horse/rider.

Withdrawals, Cancellations and Refunds

In the event of a Withdrawal, the event organiser **MUST** be notified ASAP along with the substitute if applicable
See rule G2.1.2 Postponed Qualifiers in the event of event cancellation

Hats

All hats must have a visible **current PINK** BRC/BE/PC hat tag in place before they are worn at the event. There will be a trained official available on the day to tag hats. For up to date hat rules please see the current BRC Handbook.

Body Protectors

A body protector to the current BRC standard as per the BRC Handbook must be worn for this competition. The current standard accepted is the **BETA 2018 Blue Label**. The only exception to this is the Exo Body Cages which will still be accepted, but must have a BETA Level 3 2000 Label. The rider must also inform the secretary at the event that they will be using an Exo Body Cage.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations following rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook.

BRC Code of Conduct/Showground Rules

The BRC code of conduct must be observed at all BRC events, this includes the conduct of members, officials, volunteers and representatives. A full summary of the BRC code of conduct can be found in section 1 page 3 of the BRC handbook. This includes, horse/pony welfare, safeguarding, equality and diversity, good conduct and discipline and social media. Any person on the show ground must follow all instructions that are made.

Paramedics & vet will be in attendance on the day.

All other areas at the venue apart from parking, warmup and competition are strictly out of bounds Non-compliance will result in elimination and a ban from this venue.

Please clear all droppings and hay before you leave. No mucking out of lorries into the carpark.

All dogs to be kept on short leads. Please clear up after your dog!

The organisers and land owners will not hold themselves responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever, however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
