Combined Training competition for Senior and Junior teams of 4 and Individuals to be run under BRC rules.

Team of 4.

Both Junior and Seniors teams will have 2 members jumping 75cm (one riding Prelim 7 (2002) dressage and the other Prelim14 (2006)) and 2 members jumping 85cm (one riding Novice 24 (2010) dressage and the other Novice 30 (2006)).

Individuals

Individuals can ride any test/height.

Horses can compete twice - either as part of a team and as an individual OR they can enter twice as an individuals – in both cases, the dressage test/height MUST be different.

Closing Date: Monday 21st March 2022

All qualifier entrants must pay a prelim entry to British Riding Clubs at least 21 days before the date of the qualifier (above).

Prelim entry forms for postal entries can be downloaded from the BRC website (www.britishridingclubs.org.uk). Online prelim entries can be made via the BHS bookshop ([Late prelim entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organiser with a late surcharge of £20 per team and £10 per individual, if there are sufficient spaces. No major changes will be accepted after 3pm on Thursday 31st March 2022. Only straight substitutions will be accepted after this time, i.e. name of horse and/or rider taken out and replaced by another. No movements from one team to another will be allowed after this time.

Approximate class times will be published on the WARC website (www.witteringacademy.com) no later than 3 days prior to competition and will depend on number of entries.

Teams are required to provide 2 helpers per team or per 3 individuals entered. Names and contact details of helpers should be provided at the time of entry. Failure to provide helps could result in elimination of teams.

Rules

This competition will run under **British Riding Club Rules**. It is important that all competitors are aware of the rules and eligibility relating to this competition – please see the current BRC Handbook and also the BRC Rule Amendments and Changes Document which can be found at the link below: <http://www.bhs.org.uk/enjoy-riding/british-riding-clubs/brc-rulebook>

COVID guidelines will be applied as they are applicable on the day.

Please note only one competitor per test will qualify when using more than one arena Appendix 11 in the rulebook will be applied to resolve the qualifying place.

If the date of the qualifier is cancelled for any reason, the close of prelim entry will remain. However, if the qualifier is moved more than 21 days later, entries will be re-opened but late entry fees cannot be refunded. Eligibility will be approved at the original close of prelim entry.

All hats must have a visible aqua BRC hat tag in place before they are used for warming up and competing, to show that it meets the current safety standards. There will be a trained official available on the day to do this for you if your hat does not currently have one. For up to date hat rules please see the current rule book.

Your horse must have up to annual influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Rulebook.

The organisers and land owners will not hold themselves responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, and spectators or any other person or property whatsoever, however caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident
